Using a rotating stage, Feet off the Ground blend contemporary dance with poetry and an evocative soundscape to unravel women's stories of protest, climate, community and hope.

Together the four performers journey through exhaustion, celebration and solidarity; expressing the freedom, resilience and spirit it takes to care for each other and the world we live in.



FEET OFF THE GROUND

Feet off the Ground creates transformative, relatable outdoor dance productions which comment on socio-political issues through a feminist lens. The work reflects the company's collective belief in the therapeutic benefit of movement, human connection and touch, and their democratic and collaborative approach to creating dance.

The collective have performed and taught both nationally and internationally including: OffBeat Festival (Oxford), The Place Family Dance Day (London), Chisenhale Summer of Art (London), Let's Do London (Trafalgar Square & Canary Wharf, London), Deptford Lounge (London) Sustainability Hub Big Weekend - The Point (Eastleigh), GraciasXfavor Festival (Santander, Spain), Art Night (Southbank, London), Play Circus Festival (Wales).





TECH REQUIREMENTS

Designed as an outdoor work, but can be performed indoors, in the round or in a semi-circle.

4 dancers, 1 production manager travelling with non-motorised rotating stage. Stage breaks down into pieces. Circumference when in place - 3m, height 1m.

2.5 hr set up, 1.5 hr take down with 1hr break before performance.

Playing space - 8x8m with height of min 5m.

PA system for pre-recorded sound.

Flat surface, no soft areas.

No lighting design as designed for outdoor during daytime. Lighting can be discussed further if indoor venue.

Suitable for all ages. 50 mins, no interval.
